### Forming Adverbs of Manner

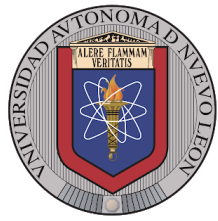
Adjective	Adverb	What changes?

happy	happily	Adjectives that finish in -Y change -Y by -I and add LY

good	well	Irregular forms
fast	fast	
hard	hard

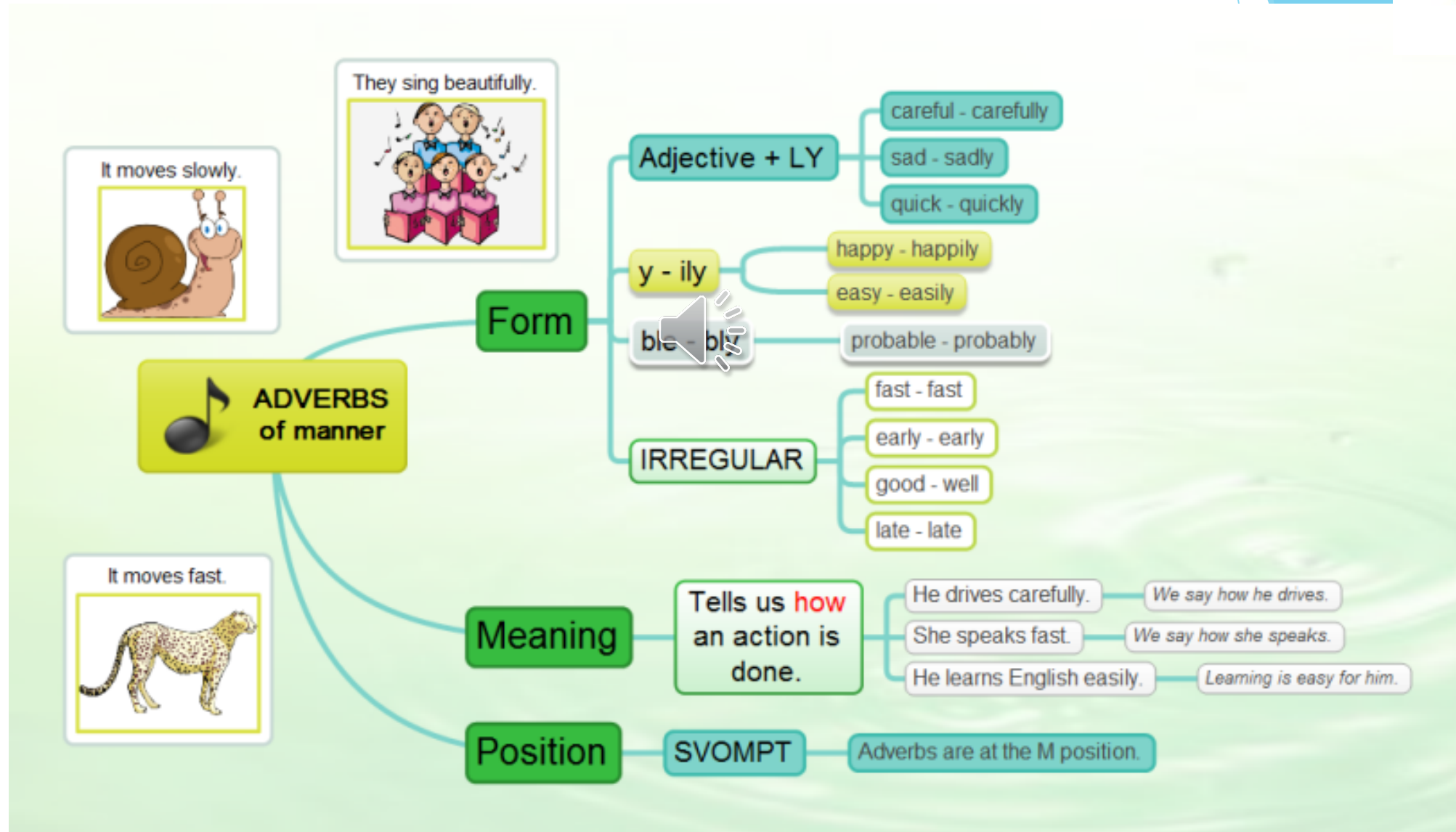

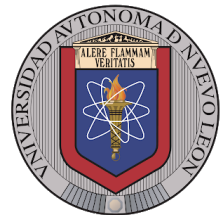
# FROM ADJECTIVE TO ADVERB



<b>adjective</b>	<b>+</b>	<b>ly</b>	<b>=</b>	<b>adverb</b>
<i>slow</i>	+	<i>ly</i>	=	<i>slowly</i>
<i>fluent</i>	+	<i>ly</i>	=	<i>fluently</i>
<i>careful</i>	+	<i>ly</i>	=	<i>carefully</i>
<i>beautiful</i>	+	<i>ly</i>	=	<i>beautifully</i>

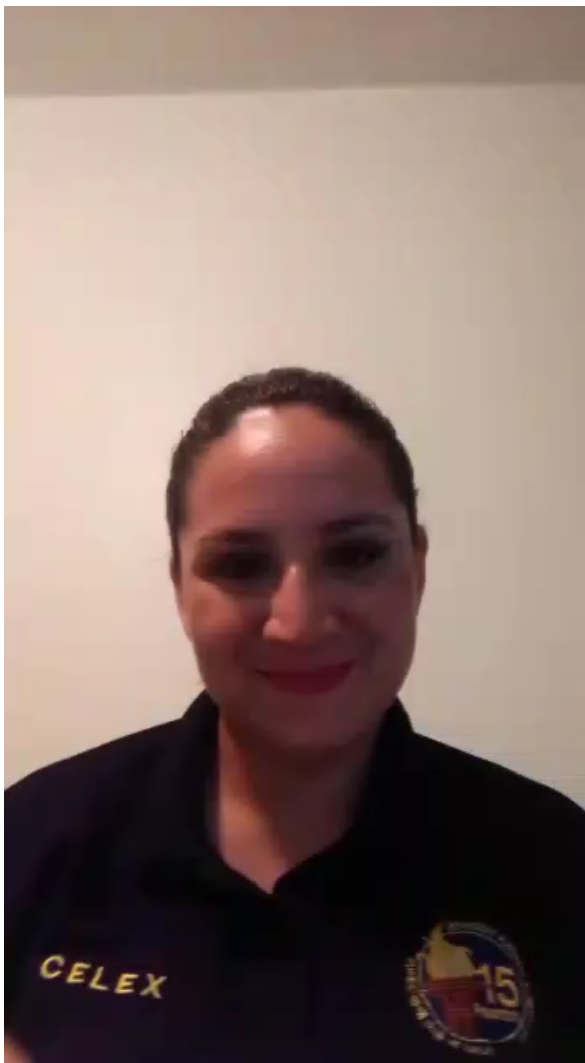
