

beautiful	beautifully	
slow	slowly	Adjective + LY
bad	badly	
happy	happily	Adjectives that finish in -Y
noisy	noisily	change -Y by -I and add LY
easy	easily	
good	well	
fast	fast	Irregular forms
hard	hard





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FROM ADJECTIVE TO ADVERB



adjective	+	ly	=	adverb
<i>slow</i>	+	<i>ly</i>	=	<i>slowly</i>
<i>fluent</i>	+	<i>ly</i>	=	<i>fluently</i>
<i>careful</i>	+	<i>ly</i>	=	<i>carefully</i>
<i>beautiful</i>	+	<i>ly</i>	=	<i>beautifully</i>




